Vintage racers enjoyed beautiful fall Oklahoma weather, the gracious Stephens family hospitality, and lots of track time. What a meal! Hallett always has good parties and good eats, but this year our own Sam LeComte and the Group-1 "chefs" really rocked.

The first race for each group was 15 minutes on Saturday morning. Saturday afternoon's race and both Sunday races were all 20 minutes long, so everyone had a chance for 75 minutes of racing time, not counting practice and qualifying sessions. This was mostly a result of combining Group 1 and Group 7 for this event.

Formula Vees were the featured group at Thunder IX, so in addition to their four regular race sessions, the Sunday lunchtime feature race was a half-hour Victory Lane Formula Vee Festival. By Monday morning, a lot of FV drivers were tired and sore!

Chief Steward Greg Reynolds noted "If you missed Hallett you missed one of the best weekends of the year...the Formula Vee Festival was fun to watch with the usual very close racing from the front to the rear." Tom Atlas joined us all the way from Illinois to pace the starts in his thoroughly modern white Porsche. It was good to see Tom again at Hallett.

CVAR past-President Art Summerville served as Race Chairman, and our regular Chief of Flag & Comm was off to work the Petite LeMans series at Road Atlanta, so Sam Heumann stepped up and took over those duties. Kerry McEntire did double duty as Tech Inspector, in addition to racing his own car (try it sometime; he was very busy all weekend – thanks, Kerry). Bob Green II has taken the additional position of Operations Chief, a job previously held by Judy Green. Many thanks to all of those who make our racing possible.

The "Formula Vee Festival" 30 minute race kicked off the Sunday afternoon feature races. Seventeen drivers came to the grid, but it was

Jerry Urban's yellow & black #711 Zink who took the checkered flag a half hour later, winning overall and taking first in the FV1 class. The next eight finishers were in the FV class, with Bill Griffith's red #5 Beach taking second overall and first in the FV class. Third and fourth overall were Mike Callahan, white & blue #68 Zink, and Dwight Calkins, red #78 Lynx, after quite a battle. Mike nipped Dwight by a scant 4/10 of a second.

The pre-'60 **Group 4** field was significantly smaller, but showcased several historically significant cars. First across the finish line was Oklahoma City's Chip Fudge, driving his exworks, ex-Archie Scott-Brown, Lister-Maserati, green #56, to win CM class. Jeff Norris finished second overall and second in CM with his black #44 Lola Mk1. Allen Johnson's red #1 Devin-MGA finished third overall and third in CM. The next two finishers were in VB class, with John Page, white #61 Alfa Romeo Spider Veloce, ahead of Jack McClanahan, green & white #104 Austin Healey 100-4. In his first event after driver's school, Gary McFarlane drove a clean race in his white #91 "Thundermug" H-Modified

sports racer, powered by Crosley, taking the unopposed win in VC class.

The Group 6 race for FA, FF1, FF2 and BSR included a field of fourteen starters. Twenty minutes later, Mexico's Patricio Junco took the overall win in his new (to him) red #21 Merlyn 20A, winning FF1 class as well. Second overall and winner of FF2 class was Ed Copley driving his red #07 Lola T-340, just 1.5 seconds back. Kent Liming, driving his red #15 Centaur FSV won the FA class, finishing eighth overall. Next behind Kent came Lee Lydick in his bright yellow #22 Merlyn Mk6A to win B Sports Racing class unopposed.

A small turnout of Group 1 and Group 7 entrants was grouped together for the next race, with CVAR Chief Steward Greg Reynolds taking the overall win and the B Production class win in "big 89," his white 1967 Shelby GT-350. Greg is also co-owner of "little 89", the white English Ford Escort RS1600 driven by Don Gwynne, which finished farther back in fifth overall, for an unopposed B Sedan win, after a race-long battle with Ralf Kuehnhoefer's red #58 Porsche 911, which came sixth overall only a second back. Chad Courty was third overall and first in A Sedan in his orange #38 Camaro, setting fast lap of the race along the way. Patrick Sullivan took the C Production win, and fourth overall, driving his silver & black Porsche 914-6. In spite of finishing three laps down, Tim Webb won the D Production class in his red #28 Elva Courier.

Group 2 (EP, FP and CS) was highlighted by a rousing tussle between the historically

famous "Purple People Eater" #61 Mini Cooper S driven by Robert Hoemke and the red #02 MG Midget piloted by Herb Hilton. Hoemke won first overall and first in CS, with just a half-second margin over Hilton's Midget, who won F Production class. Ken Morris won the E Production class, ninth overall, in his black #08 MGB

Last race of the day was the Group 3 points race for FV, FV1, and SFP. A nice grid of fifteen cars took the green flag, and twenty minutes later,

"Spec Sprite" SFP class winner was Gary Emery, driving his green #31 Austin Healey Sprite.
