# **CVAR Oktoberfest**

# **Motorsports Ranch Houston, Texas**

**Sep. 30-Oct. 2, 2016**– *story by Don Gwynne* 

Perfect weather and more than 115 entrants spelled a fun and successful weekend of CVAR racing at Motorsports Ranch Houston. Event Chair Mike Briggs did a fine job of

The **GERMAN FEATURE** on Sunday morning had 18 entrants, of which 15 came to the line and 13 were classed as finishers. Carl Janin sat on pole in his white #13 Porsche RSR, with Bassam Al Haddad alongside in his #131 white Porsche 911. When the race started, Bassam jumped into the lead, and led

every lap except the one that counted most, when Mark Gohlke forged into the overall

lead in his red/ white/blue #123 Porsche 914/6. Janin finished in third overall, only to be penalized 30 seconds for failing to report to a black flag. He was far enough ahead of the next car that the penalty didn't

change the finishing results, however. Sorting the finishers by CVAR class designations, Al Haddad won the C Production class, Mark Gohlke won the FIA class, and with a fourth overall, Mike Floyd's yellow #614 Porsche 914 won the E Production class. Anthony Nigro won the EP2 class in his black

and white Porsche 914. Doug Oliver placed eighth overall to take an unopposed win in the B Sedan class driving his white and blue #140 BMW 2002.


The **GROUP 2** Championship Points race was a battle all the way between polesitter Chris Duroy in his blue #73 MG Midget and Randy Riney's black #100 MG Midget. Duroy eventually took the checker ahead of Riney to win overall and the FP class. Scott Barrett finished an excellent third overall after starting way back in tenth in his yellow #10 Austin Healey Sprite to win the FP2 class. Berkeley Merrill won the EP class in his silver #12 Porsche 914.

organizing the event. A special 30-minute feature event was a race for German cars (only), with 15 of them coming to the line (13 Porsches, 1 BMW, and 1 NSU).

During lunchtime on Saturday, exhibition rides in race cars were immensely popular, with more than 50 workers and spectators enjoying the opportunity to see "what's it like out there." On Saturday night, the rousing race party was hosted by Mike and Keri Briggs.

The GROUP 3 Championship Points race for Group 3 Formula Vees had a large field of 28 cars, with Dallasite Dwight Calkins sitting on the pole in his red #87 Lynx. Alongside Calkins was Charlie Hearn in his red #62 Vee. After the green flag, William Wolff jumped into the lead driving his white and blue #68 Zink after starting on the second row. Wolff led for about three laps before Hearn took the lead all the way to the checkered flag for the win. Nathan Baldauff carved his way up through the pack from 12th to second. Then came a DQ of Hearn's #62 for contact, giving Baldauff the overall win, and a second place finish for Wolff.

Nine drivers came to the starter's orders for the GROUP 4 Championship Points race, with Robert Merrill leading all the way from pole to checker in his yellow #159 Huffaker Mk 1 Formula Junior, for the overall win and the FJr1 class win. It is a front-engined car, powered by a Ford 105E engine. Mike Vecellio placed

RT1.4. He started on pole, and led all but one lap, to take the overall win and the FA class win. Rick Wark mounted a challenge to

> Copley, charging up from the last row to lead the third lap, but was re-passed and eventually finished a creditable third overall and second in FA class. In between Copley and Wark at the finish line was Greg Smith in his red #6 Swift DB1 for the FF3 class win. Jeff Langham took the FF1 class win, in fifth overall, driving

seventh on the grid to finish third overall and second in CP. Cynthia Trifilio started fifth overall in her blue #55 Fiat 124 Sport Coupe and finished same, to win the B Sedan class. Crowd favorite Chris Langley's blue and white #99 Yenko Stinger won the DP2 class in sixth overall.

Last race of the weekend was for the big thunder, GROUP 1. Phil Mulacek thrilled everyone by bringing out his real-deal, blue #27 427 Cobra. Phil led from flag to flag to take the overall win and the A Production class win. CVAR President Herb Hilton likewise ran in second overall from flag to flag, to win the A Sedan class in his yellow #17 Mustang. Second A Sedan and third overall was taken by Alain Vinson in his white and red #2 Mustang. Joe Robau won the B Production class in fourth overall

second overall to win the VB class in his black and white #112 EMPI Crusader. John Furlow Jr. placed third overall driving his red #38 Abarth Allemano to win the VC class. The SFP "Spec Sprite" class win went to Eddie Dick in sixth overall driving his gold #54 Austin Healey Sprite. Allen Johnson took an unopposed win in VA class in his red #5 MG TD Special.

Edward Copley proved to be the class of the GROUP 6 field in his red #43 Ralt his blue and silver Merlyn Mk 20A Formula Ford. Just behind Langham came David Bell for the FF2 class win in his blue and yellow Lola T-342, in sixth overall.

A relatively small field of just nine GROUP 7 cars came to the line, with Little Rock's Louis Gladfelter

driving his white #11 Corvette. Twelve other Group 1 cars were entered for the weekend, but didn't come to the grid for the final race for various reasons. Their loss.





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Art Evans was a sports car racer in the 1950s on the West Coast who raced against, and became close friends with, Carroll Shelby. Their intense competition on the track became a lifelong friendship off the track. For this book, they both combed through the Shelby archives and selected Shelby's favorite images from his racing career. That is almost the entirety of this book. It is packed with photos selected by Shelby himself, and the captions are quotes from Shelby's commentary on the action in the photo, as well as his memories.



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
