

#40 Edward Ziegler, Merlyn Mk6A.

Vintage race cars, drivers, workers, and spectators converged on Texas World Speedway for a weekend festival of speed and fun. In addition to the vintage racing, CVAR conducted a highly successful drivers school, which drew 14 new vintage racing drivers into the fold. The course used is the 2.9-mile combination of twisty turns and short straights in the infield

area, combined with a portion of the banked super speedway tri-oval.

Texas World Speedway was built in 1969 and is one of only seven Super Speedways of two miles or greater in the U.S., the others being Indianapolis, Daytona, Pocono, Talladega, California, and Michigan.

Friday started with low fog and drizzle, but the day brightened up and the track dried, much to the relief of all, especially the student drivers. Saturday and Sunday were glorious, with blue Texas skies and gentle breezes.

During the Saturday morning drivers meeting, CVAR President George Curl introduced Bill Mather, the new owner of Texas Motor Speedway. Mather, an ex-Marine, assured the group that although he knows little about racing, he knows how to take good care of valuable property, and that he intends the Speedway to remain open in support of the

surrounding property. He strongly emphasized that he did not buy TWS to plow it under for a housing development, which was very well received by everyone present.

Group 5 was assigned to the students and their instructors. The student drivers drove a very diverse group of cars, including a Corvette, two Mustangs, two Camaros, a Porsche 911, three Porsche 914s, two Alfa Romeos, an MGB, a Triumph Spitfire, and a Formula Vee. Unlike

the Saturday preliminary qualifying and race sessions, Sunday's race results count towards CVAR's 2008 Championship determinations.

Winner of Sunday's **Group 1** (A Sedan, A Production, B Production, and FIA classes) points race was Sam LeComte, driving his blue #67 Camaro A Sedan. Second overall and first in

FIA class was Seth Higgins driving his new (to him) brown #31 Porsche 911 RSR. Third overall and second in FIA class was Ron Shade driving his blue & yellow #810 Porsche 911.

Tim Johnson drove his white and green #7 MGB to the overall win and EP win in **Group 2** (E Production, F Production, and C Sedan). Herb Hilton finished second overall and first in FP driving his red and white #02 MG Midget, with Jay McClanahan next in his #113 silver MG Midget. Rodger Soucy won C Sedan in his blue #155 Mini, while Brant Barnes in the silver #48 Mini ran into carburetion problems and Sam Partin's red #44 Alfa Junior had transmission problems.

The **Group 3** (Formula Vee and Spec FF) race went to Team Geezer's Mike Callahan, driving his white #68 Zink FV. His teammate John Gaudette had to settle for third in his blue #66 Zink FV, with Jim Yule taking second in his green #77 Kalman FV. A bit further back in the Group 3 pack, Mike Vecellio drove his (Spec) yellow #3 MG Midget to the SFP win.

CVAR's historic **Group 4** (VA, VB, VC, CM, DSR, FFJr, FJr) showcased many beautiful older cars.

Bruce Revennaugh took the overall win and the FFJr win driving his dark green #150 front engined Elva 100 Formula Junior. Pablo Gonzalez from Santa Catarina, Mexico, took

second overall and second FFJr in his green & yellow #20 Lotus 20. John Page placed third overall and first in VB driving his white #61 Alfa Romeo Guilia Spider.

Scott Monroe took the Group 6 (FA, FB, FF1, FF2, BSR) win driving his bright yellow #80 March 80A FA, ahead of second place finisher Steve Smith in his bright red #27 Merlyn Mk20 FA. Patricio Junco of San Pedro, Mexico, placed third overall and first in FF1 driving his blue Lotus 51B Formula Ford. Steven Jacobs won FF2 with his white & red Dulon MP-15 Formula Ford. Edward Ziegler's blue

and orange Merlyn Mk6A won the B Sports Racing class.

The Group 7 (CP, DP, BS) race turned into a Teutonic romp. George Kopecky's psychedelic #97 Porsche 911 took the overall win and the C Production win, followed by Steve Kent driving the red #58 Porsche 911, and by Ned Cullen in his white & maroon Porsche 911. Many of the B Sedan entrants encountered mechanical problems on Saturday, and one more gremlin popped up on the grid for Sunday's race, leaving only two BS cars at the start. Bill Thacker won B Sedan driving his lime green #175 BMW 2002. D Production was won by Bob Kramer, driving his veteran TR-4A. Bob's red and blue Triumph has a long and proud racing history, including the SCCA's American Road Race of Champions national runoffs at Daytona in 1967 and at Riverside in 1968.
