

**Corinthian Vintage Auto Racing Corporation, CVAR**  
**Minutes of Board of Directors (BoD) Special Meeting**  
**Wednesday, 11 February 2026**  
**Zoom Call**

1. Attendees:

2. Call to order: The meeting was opened at 6:06 pm by John Strnad. Simon Hughes was not present and assigned John Strnad as Proxy.
3. Meeting minutes for the January 17, 2026 Annual Meeting were presented by Steven Schultze. The minutes stand.
4. John Strnad provided an update on the upcoming race at MSR Houston. The operations team and race chairs are actively preparing and reporting progress to him. There are currently over 70 entries. Emails continue to be sent to encourage additional registrations. The late registration fee begins on February 19, 2026. The projected break-even point is 100 entries.
5. Ricardo Price shared an update regarding Porsche fuel tanks. Porsche 944 fuel tanks with the factory system are allowed under SCCA rules. A rule change proposal will be submitted.
6. Championship points are provisional and have been posted on the website. John Strnad and Mark McIlyar will contact Simon Hughes to ensure the 2025 awards are ready for presentation at the Eagles Canyon race in March.
7. David Lee presented the membership-submitted candidates for the annual awards. He will obtain the required awards for presentation.
  - a. Lifetime Achievement Award candidates were Steve Coleman and Bill Griffith. During the Board call, Herb Hilton was also nominated. David Lee moved that all three candidates be presented to the membership for a vote. The motion was seconded by Andy Samudio and carried unanimously.
  - b. The McLaughlin Trophy candidates were Jeff Moore and Tom Dalrymple. The candidates were put to a vote. Tom Dalrymple received 8 votes, Jeff Moore

received 0 votes, and two members abstained. Tom Dalrymple will receive the McLaughlin Trophy.

- c. Green Family Worker Award candidates were Bob Roy and Merl Hanson. The Board discussed presenting the award to both candidates. David Lee moved to award both individuals. The motion was seconded by John Strnad and carried unanimously.
8. Steven Schultze presented an inconsistency in Drivers School registration pricing between the spring and fall events. The Board discussed the actual costs to conduct the school and the overall value provided to entrants. Steven Schultze moved to approve the following Drivers School registration package, effective with the upcoming MSR Houston school. The motion was seconded by John Strnad and carried unanimously.
    - a. Drivers School registration fee will be \$850
    - b. Upon successful completion of Drivers School, the entrant will receive:
      - i. Competition Membership for the calendar year in which the school is completed
      - ii. Three \$50 race entry discounts to be applied to the three required races to be completed within 12 months in order to obtain a Competition License.
      - iii. If a driver does not require all three races to complete licensing requirements, discounts will apply only to the number of races necessary to complete the Novice Permit process.
  9. Jackson Lee discussed the Youthful Driver Assistance Program used by SOVREN and will explore how CVAR might implement a similar program.
  10. Steven Schultze shared a discussion he and John Strnad had with Victory Lane magazine regarding marketing opportunities. We agreed to spend \$500 to have the 2026 race schedule published. Andy Samudio agreed to research additional marketing options with Victory Lane, including scope, approach, and a potential budget.
  11. Steven Schultze shared that Novice Permit tracking will move online into Track Rabbit beginning with the MSR Houston Drivers School. Once verified to be functioning properly, Probation tracking will also transition to Track Rabbit. Moving these processes into Track Rabbit will reduce the risk of lost permits and prevent documents from being left with the Chief Steward at the end of a race weekend.
  12. Steven Schultze shared that the Winner's Circle banner sponsored by Ed Ziegler will continue to be used through the 2026 race season to ensure the value of Ed's sponsorship is fulfilled.
  13. Steven Schultze suggested that the \$25 guest entrant fee be applied to CVAR members who are not Competition or Lifetime Members. The Board did not agree, and no further action was taken.

14. Jackson Williams discussed the need to develop a comprehensive list of CVAR assets, including associated costs, to better plan for maintenance and replacement. John Strnad and Jackson Williams agreed to take action to create the asset list.
15. John Strnad provided the Board with an update on the Sunoco sponsorship plan.
16. Mark McIlyar requested that Board members provide updated photos and contact information for the distribution list.
17. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:37 pm.
